Her painted story quilts blur the lines between craft and fine art while stitching together the importance of family, cultural roots, and artistic collaboration.

From scenes laced with social commentary, cultural affirmation, myth, history, or a simple love for life in all its beauty and folly, to abstract pieces that challenge viewers to consider new perspectives, these artists have created memorable images that stand alone as well as they stand together.

Her collages often depict versions of what she calls an “intergalactic Afrofuturistic time-traveling woman warrior.” Modern-day heroines and Black cultural icons are also prominently featured in her works. The radically empowering, female-centric creations in this calendar create a fully immersive ambiance, setting the tone for your year.

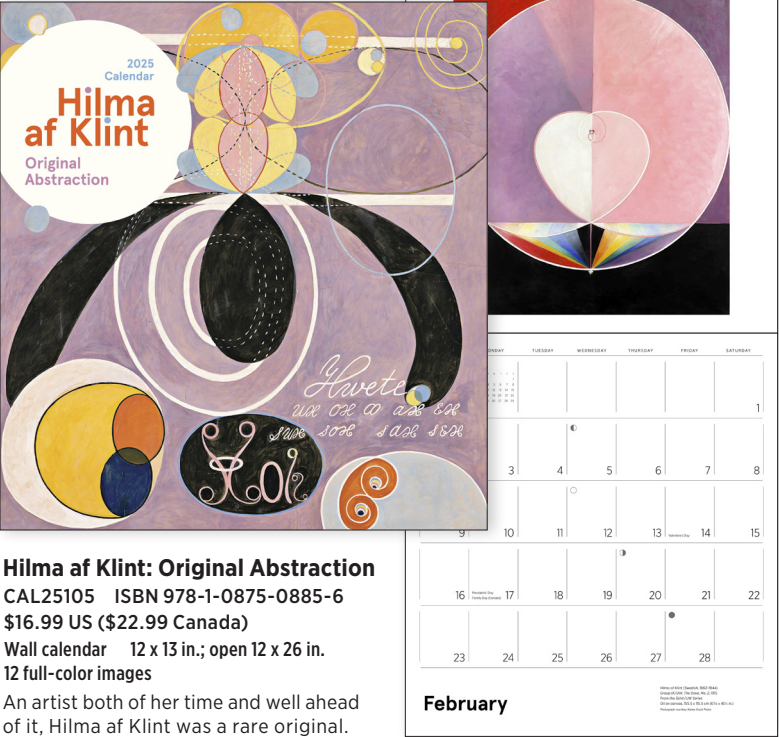

His introspective paintings are laced with clues and symbolism about society’s virtues and vices. Is the toucanet in *The Hearth* reminding viewers to keep the home fires burning, or is it sounding a silent alarm that our spiritual house is on fire? The enigmatic paintings in this calendar encourage us to read between the lines, ask questions about the world at large, and celebrate the circle of life all throughout the year.

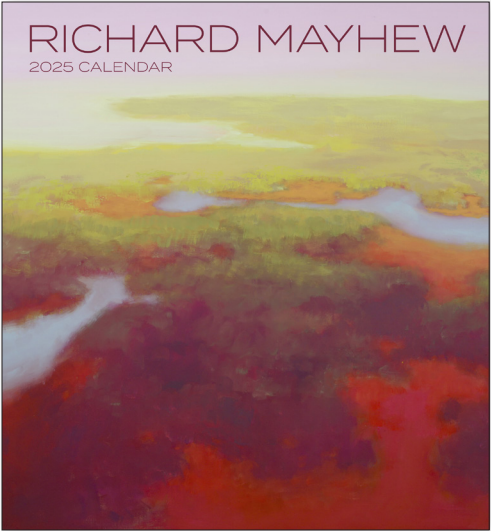
In Mexican culture, the dead remain alive in our memories. Día de los Muertos—celebrated on November first and second each year—represents days when the veils are thin between worlds and those still on Earth can pay tribute to their ancestors and friends who have passed. When welcoming the dead back to the realm of the living, *ofrendas* (altars) are created and adorned with candles, flowers, offerings of food and drink, and often *calaveras* (skull decorations). Mexican American artists Tino Rodriguez and Virgo Paraiso offer vibrant takes on *calaveras* in the jaw-dropping images in this calendar.





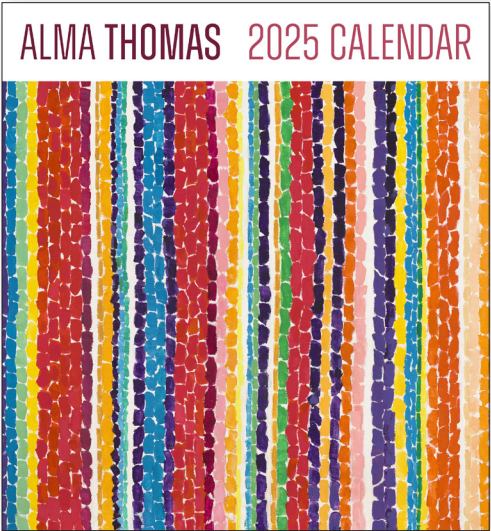
**Hilma af Klint: Original Abstraction**

An artist both of her time and well ahead of it, Hilma af Klint was a rare original. Years before Modernist pioneers Mondrian and Kandinsky dipped into abstraction, af Klint broke ground with colorful, energetic compositions that veered away from the figurative. Influenced by spiritualism, she tried to reconcile art, science, and religious pluralism through her paintings. Determining that the world wasn't ready, she decreed that her work—now celebrated—not be exhibited for 20 years after her death.



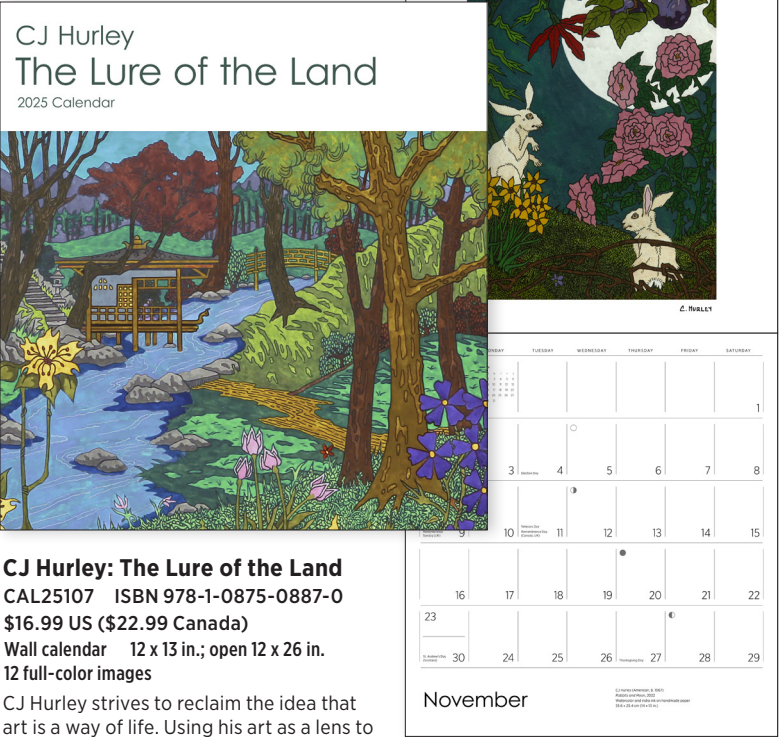

The artist himself was immersed in the Civil Rights struggle, but he resists depicting overt themes of ethnicity or culture. Saturated with color and illusion, Mayhew’s works evoke both the earthly and the transcendental.



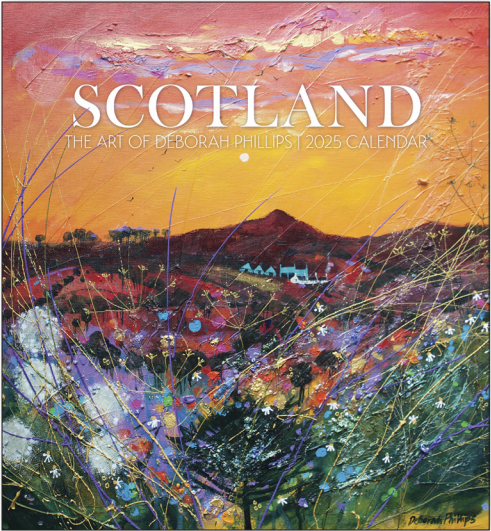

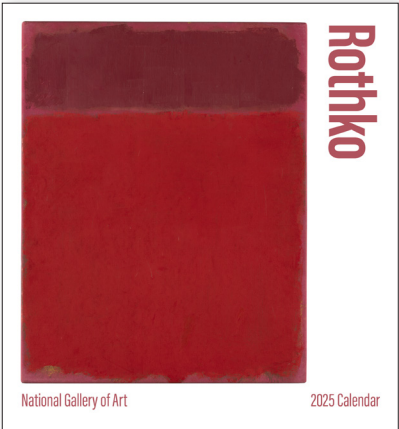
Dynamic composition and strong color form a common thread in the diverse, career-spanning works of midcentury American artist Richard Diebenkorn. One of the most influential artists during the decades after World War II, his work encompassed three major artistic evolutions: the Sausalito, Albuquerque, Urbana, and early Berkeley periods of Abstract Expressionism; the Berkeley figurative/representational period; and the Ocean Park and Healdsburg series of abstractions. The paintings in this calendar were created during the Ocean Park years.

Mark Rothko

A titan among Modern painters, Mark Rothko once said that the subject matter of his paintings was the extremes of human emotion. His extraordinary achievement was the communication of tragedy and elation through forms reduced to starkest simplicity—oftentimes a pair of rectangles. Born Marcus Rothkowitz in a Latvian Jewish community, the artist emigrated to the United States at the age of 10. After a series of artistic metamorphoses, he established himself as a leader among New York’s artistic avant-garde in the late 1940s. Rothko worked on large canvases, but he felt that the scale was intimate, establishing a close physical relationship with the viewer. Discover the power of Rothko’s deceptively simple compositions in these 2025 calendars.

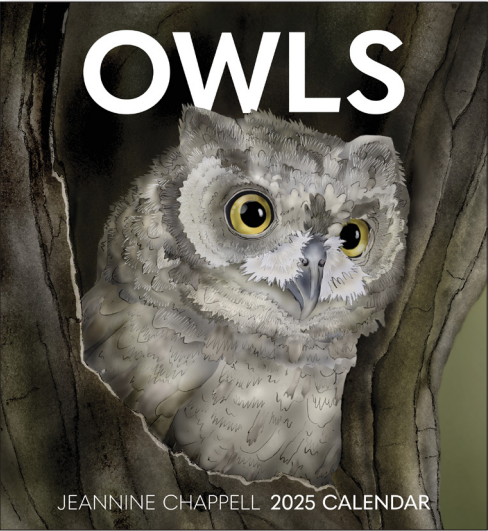

William Seltzer Rice found endless inspiration in nature, creating a vast number of watercolors, drawings, photographs, etchings, and block prints. He arrived in Northern California in 1900, the early days of the region’s Arts and Crafts movement. Rice taught in several schools, including the California College of Arts and Crafts in Oakland—a center for the movement. As a medium, block printing suited the Arts and Crafts ethos of making artwork available to a wide audience at modest cost. Being a skilled craftsman as well as an artist, Rice designed, carved, and printed all the blocks himself.

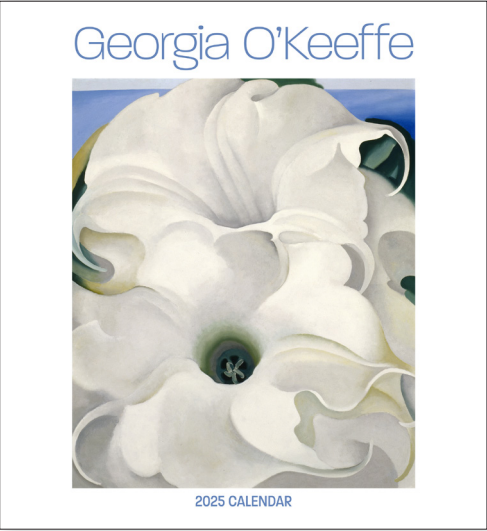

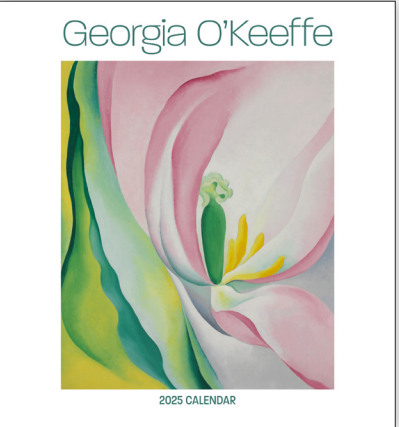

**Georgia O’Keeffe**

Bold in color and composition but with a remarkable, sensual sensitivity, Georgia O’Keeffe’s paintings stunned critics and the public alike. A pioneer of Modernism, she walked her own path in the art world, making noteworthy and influential progress without sounding any great fanfare of her own. O’Keeffe lived to be 98 years old and completed over 2,000 works—an oeuvre that has forever left its stamp on American art.



Filled with swirling patterns in jewel tones and gold, Gustav Klimt's glamorous paintings of women epitomize the Austrian Art Nouveau movement known as the Vienna Secession. One of its cofounders, Klimt produced works of startling power, symbolism, and eroticism. Portraits of women from Vienna's social elite would come to dominate his career, but he also produced daring landscapes and other disarmingly abstract scenes, culminating in his "Golden Phase," when he used gold leaf in many of his paintings. Claude Monet is widely considered one of the greatest painters in the history of art. With agile brushwork and a then-daring artistic style, he captured his impressions of nature in everyday settings. Monet was fascinated by the interplay of sunlight, breezes, and water, and he devoted himself to perfecting the depiction of light and atmosphere.
